Explanation of the Currencies of the various Countries.

AUSTRIA AND RUSSIA.—The Paper Currencies are continually subject to important fluctuations. In FRANCE, BELGIUM, SWITZERLAND, AND ITALY, 1 franc = 100 centimes. GERMANY, 1 mark = 100 pfennig. HOLLAND, 1 florin or guilder = 100 cents. NORWAY, SWEDEN, AND DENMARK, 1 kroner = 100 öre. UNITED STATES, 1 dollar = 100 cents. SPAIN, 1 peseta = 100 centavos. AUSTRIA, 1 florin = 100 kreuzer. PORTUGAL, 1 milreis = 1000 reis. GREECE, 1 drachma = 100 lepta. TURKEY, 1 piaster = 40 paras. RUSSIA, 1 rouble = 100 copecks.

Italian notes and silver are not current in France, Belgium, and Switzerland, but the silver of these countries passes current in Italy.
