 In FRANCE, BELGIUM, SWITZERLAND, AND ITALY. 1 franc=100 centimes. GERMANY, 1 mark=100 pfennig.
 HOLLAND. 1 florin or gulden=100 cents. NORWAY, SWEDEN, AND DENMARK, 1 kroner=100 ore. UNITED STATES, 1 dollar=100 cents. SPAIN, 1 peseta=100 centavos. AUSTRIA, 1 florin=100 kreuzer. PORTUGAL, 1 milreis=1000 reis.
 GREECE, 1 drachma=100 leptas. TURKEY, 1 piaster=40 paras. RUSSIA, 1 rouble=100 copecks.
 Italian notes and silver are not current in France, Belgium, and Switzerland, but the silver of these countries passes current in Italy.
